#### Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time (A) Sunday 12th February, 2023

Ecclesiasticus 15.16-21 Psalm 118 1 Corinthians 2.6-10 Matthew 5.17-37

The 'Sermon on the Mount' from Matthew's Gospel is seen as Jesus' great teaching, where Matthew portrays him as the New Moses offering the New Law. It covers three chapters of the Gospel and is full of wonderful and memorable instruction, very challenging indeed.

St Paul frequently insists that the earlier covenant enshrined in the Law proved impossible to fulfil; Jesus in today's reading insists that the New Law is even more strict:. Nevertheless, in reflecting on any text of Scripture we are called to see it, not in isolation, but in a context and in the light of co-texts, in order to understand Jesus' vision of the kingdom.

The writer of Ecclesiasticus insists: 'If you wish, you can keep the commandments, to behave faithfully is within your power.' by the grace of God, for those who wish it. Paul writing to the Corinthians offers a further dimension –entering into the realm of mystery and wisdom – the realm of God where the Spirit dwells and guides.

Discipleship is discerning God's call by using the wisdom that comes from faith and accepting the indwelling of the Spirit that has been given us
