SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER (A) Sunday 21st May, 2023

Acts 1.12-14 Psalm 26 1 Peter 4.13-16 John 17.1-11

John mentions the 'continuous prayer' in the Gospel passage preparing the reader for the events of Pentecost. This is part of Jesus' so - called 'High Priestly prayer'. The second part of John's Gospel (13–21) is sometimes called 'the Book of Glory', because that theme runs through that section is a major theme in today's passage. When John speaks of glory, he is using the word in a very restricted sense because the glory Jesus talks of is the whole movement of Jesus through his Passion and death on the cross, through to his Resurrection and appearance to the disciples and his return to the Father. The cross reveals Christ's glory for John.

The first part of today's Gospel emphasises the way in which Jesus and the Father share in that glory, their total inter-relatedness. In the second part of the passage, Jesus expresses how he now shares that glory with his disciples; that is with the Church. It is an expression of how the Church shares in the very life of God, through the Paschal Mystery the community of believers incorporated into the life of God. That is true for the community described in our first reading from Acts, it is also true of the community gathered in worship today.
