NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (A) Sunday 13th August, 2023

1 Kings 19.9,11–13 Psalm 84 Romans 9.1–5 Matthew 14.22–33

Much of Paul's work was outside of Palestine in the Roman world. Thus he is described as the Gentiles apostle.

In the Gospel and first reading, the power of God is revealed to his servants. Elijah, who had wanted to abandon his calling and be allowed to die, has been restored physically and spiritually and so enabled to carry on his prophetic calling.

God's power will be with the prophet when he returns to do battle with the forces of Baal. It is interesting to contrast the account of Jesus walking on the water in Matthew with the account in Mark. Matthew has a much more positive attitude to the disciples and, especially to Peter throughout the Gospel. Peter is to be the rock on which the Church is to be built, and at the end of this miracle when Jesus gets into the boat, the disciples bow down before and declare: 'Truly you are the Son of God.' This more positive attitude, however, makes Peter's denial and the disciples' flight at Gethsemane all the more disappointing. That is worth reflecting on for those called by the Lord to be bearers of the gospel.
