## TWENTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (A)

### Sunday 20th August, 2023

**Isaiah 56.1,6–7 Psalm 66 Romans 11.13–15, 29–32 Matthew 15.21–28**

Jesus cures people because of their faith – but it is interesting to note when dealing with the centurion's servant (8.5–13) he comments publicly on the depth of faith of two pagans.

When the woman in today's Gospel persists, Jesus does not answer her directly but addresses his disciples. His subsequent words to them carry the implication that she is a house dog. The woman, however, knows only the suffering of her daughter and how desperate she is, and so will accept the insult if it can bring healing. When Jesus tells his disciples 'I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel', he would be following a received perception of Israel as God's chosen people, to the exclusion of others, and yet Isaiah had already – as we see in the first reading – indicated that the God of Israel was not exclusive but could accept foreigners too.

Paul emphasises how the conversion of pagans is linked to the rejection of Jesus by the Jews, and yet both are ultimately destined for redemption. All He gives can be a cause of rejoicing for all. 'God never takes back his gifts or revokes his choice.
