THIRTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (A) Sunday 19th November, 2023

Ezekiel 34.11–12,15–17 Psalm 22 1 Corinthians 15.20–26,28 Matthew 25.31–46

The first reading from Ezekiel reveals God as the shepherd who personally watches over the sheep, who gathers the lost and watches over the weak; it is a very reassuring image of a 'true shepherd'. The final sentence, however, brings in a theme of judgement, which dominates the Gospel. The one who comes 'as a shepherd' in the parable 'comes in glory, escorted by all the angels'.

The 'Son of Man' is the King who takes the seat of judgement and separates those gathered before him 'as a shepherd separates sheep from goats'. When the King tells them of their actions, which bring reward or condemnation, they fail to recognise themselves, because they fail to recognise in the all-powerful judge who is in glory with the angels, the destitute to whose needs they have responded in action.

In his version of the beatitudes in the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus give profound promises to those whose lives reflect the values of the kingdom. By identifying the King who judges with the destitute, Matthew gives us a radical and challenging lesson in what it means to belong to the shepherd.
