FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT (B) & THE NATIVITY OF THE LORD Sunday 24th December, 2023

Samuel 7.1–5,8–12,14,16 Psalm 88 Romans 16.25–27 Luke 1.26–38

Samuel anointed the youngest of Jesse's sons, **David**, left with the sheep. When Gabriel is sent to Nazareth to a Virgin betrothed to Joseph. Mary's name is spelt out. **David and Mary** are among the most significant people in the Judaeo-Christian tradition. Their key roles are simply the result of God's choice, entirely dependent on grace. When David wants to build a house for God, his offer is however dismissed.

'The Lord will make you a house.' Mary and David are invited to allow themselves to be instruments of God's plans – to simply co-operate with the grace abundantly given: 'Let what you have said be done to me.'

The house that God builds for David is a sovereignty that will always stand secure. And Mary will herself become the dwelling of the Most High. These important insights offered today reveal the way God works. Human beings can carry out their task as they receive the grace from above; God's plan will be realised through human acceptance and cooperation. As Christians awaiting the celebration of 'God with us', we can ponder these truths related to us too.

Altar Servers Any person who has received Holy Communion is eligible to become an altar server. Please, let Fr Emile know if you would like to join a programme to become an altar server.

First Communion Programme Children who would like to prepare to receive Holy Communion need to register for the programme which will begin later in the year, Children need to be at least 7 years old (Year 3 in school or above). Please register with the Parish Office as soon as possible so that we can organise all the requirements. Any parent who is willing to assist as a catechist, please, speak to Fr Emile. **The deadline for submitting applications will be January 1st, 2024.**

Confirmations - The Confirmation preparation is for young men and women who are presently in year 11. It allows them to reflect on their own relationship with God and to explore with other young people some of the questions they may have about their faith.
