PENTECOST (B) Sunday 19th May, 2024

Acts 2.1–11 Psalm 103 1 Corinthians 12.3–7,12–13 or Galatians 5.16–25 John 15.26–27; 16.12–15

The Feast of Pentecost (= 50 days) concludes the season of Easter with the celebration of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit.

Eucharistic celebrations offer the faithful the chance to perceive the presence of the Holy Spirit which focusses on its working in the life of the community of the faithful.

The story of Babel, the account of the theophany on Sinai, the vision of the dry bones and the prophecy of Joel all give an opportunity to explore the mysterious working and effects of the Holy Spirit. The workings of God cannot be contained in simple human categories of time and space. It is the very essence of God as Holy Spirit that the person of the Spirit may not be restricted and contained by language and human constructs. The Spirit, as God, is inevitably beyond comprehension, and so we are invited always to enter deeper into mystery.

The reading give us a way of perceiving the Spirit in the effects that the Spirit brings – and such effects are surely able to be experienced, recognised and spoken about. That has been the reality that the faithful have known since the first Pentecost.
