SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER (B)

Sunday 5th May, 2024

Acts 10.25–26,34–35,44–48 Psalm 97 1 John 4.7–10 John 15.9–17

Love can help prepare us for the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity which we celebrate in two weeks' time. Love is such a profound emotion in human beings that it is easy to perceive of it as being rooted in ourselves.

'For Christians, God's love for humankind is the foundation of all human experience of love. All love has its origin in the mutual love of the three persons of the Trinity, and that love invites all to enter into, and share of, that love. A human child learns love by being loved, and if deprived of love as an infant, the effect can be devastating.

Human beings are able to love simply because they have been loved first into existence. For John speaks of love is always the starting point, linking the love of the Father for the Son with the Love of the Son for the disciples . Human love originates in the love within the Trinity. By calling his disciples (and us) friends, Jesus expressly brings them into the very life of love which is the Trinity; and as is necessarily the case within the life of the Trinity, insists that such love be fruitful.
