THIRTY FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (B) Sunday 3rd November, 2024

Deuteronomy 6.2–6 Psalm 17 Hebrews 7.23–28 Mark 12.28–34

The Shema in Deuteronomy calls the Hebrew people to affirm their fundamental identity as God's people and their faithfulness to his laws and commandments. To reach their promised land where milk and honey flow, **they must love this Lord with all their heart, soul and strength**. We are rooted in that same Deuteronomic faith. Mark's dialogue draws us vividly into the scene between one of the more sympathetic scribes and Jesus.. We are immersed in the skilful way Jesus builds someone's faith. He rehearses the Shema and adds the second commandment, the Golden Rule, **to love your neighbour as yourself**. The scribe eager to affirm all that Jesus said moves on a stage. Living like this he says is more important than ritual holocausts or sacrifices. Jesus sees in this response a true wisdom which means that, like the children of earlier weeks, the scribe is not far from the kingdom of God. Let us 'Listen' to the call out . Affirming the fundamental tenets of our faith we try to break open the Word for that particular day so that together we can reaffirm our baptismal belief in the Creed that follows the homily. Today we are called to ask people to listen intently to the heartbeat of their own faith. As with this good scribe, we must love God and our neighbour with our whole being. **To do it well is a real challenge** Christ's power to intercede for all who come to God through him. As we celebrate the Eucharist together, we are conscious of it being the action of God's faithful people, the Church gathered in that place. We come as the Body of Christ to hear his word and receive his Body and Blood acknowledging that, as the collect prays, it is by God's gift that we can offer him right and praiseworthy service.
