## THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD (C) Feast Sunday 2nd February, 2025

Luke 2:22-40 Malachi 3:1-4 Psalm 23 (24) Hebrews 2:14-18

From Fr. Adrian Graffy:

Luke's lengthy gospel reading completes for us the mystery of Christmas. Jesus becomes 'completely like his brothers'. He is brought to the Temple to begin a life of service. His future path is foreseen by Simeon and Anna. His mother's pain is also foretold. He is subject to his parents in the secret life of Nazareth. But, as Simeon already proclaims, he is set to be a 'sign of contradiction', 'a light for all the nations and the glory of his people Israel'.

How does this feast reconnect us with the Christmas mysteries?

What deeper significance does Jesus' coming to the Temple contain?

Consider on this feast of Candlemas how light is a recurring theme in Bible and liturgy.

We pray for all fathers and mothers that they may treasure their children as gifts of God.

'My eyes have seen your salvation, which you prepared in the sight of all the peoples.'
