Third Sunday in Ordinary Time (C) Peace Day Sunday 26th January, 2025

Nehemiah 8.2–4a,5–6,8–10 Psalm 19 1 Corinthians 12.12–30 Luke 1.1–4; 4.14–21

The extraordinary events of the baptism and the temptation over, the Lord returns to his home-town and goes to the synagogue ‘as was his custom’. He returns to ordinary life, to the well trodden streets, to his well-known place of worship, and to his well-kept and cherished people, and ‘he found the place...’ He found that place, his place, in the Scriptures which he would have heard time and again (even if doesn’t quote quite exactly!) but which is now revealed to him ‘in the power of the Spirit’ in a new and astounding way.

This Spirit brings him to an old but new place. The poor had always been there, as had been the oppressed, the disabled, and those deprived of freedom. It was the way life was. At this moment of revelation and recognition, this ‘today’, he knows he has been sent to proclaim the Good News of what God was doing. This is a place of epiphany just as the baptism had been, and his time in the desert, and the Spirit is at work in all.

But now the emphasis is on mission. Now he knows he must do more than read from the book as Ezra and the Levites had done. Now he knows that he belongs in one body with these people at the margins, and that they belong to him. The Spirit resting on him rests too on these and binds them into one body, his body, a sacred whole. He sees in their brokenness and pain ‘a new world, risen, stubborn with beauty, out of the heart’s need’. And perhaps already, in that today of recognition, he understood the suffering of one was the suffering of all and knew his heart would ‘bleed for them in return.
