**St. Vincent De Paul Society** St. Helen's and St. Margaret's have had a SVP for many years. There are at present six members. Peter Davenport, Lauren Gardner, Ann Jackson, Clara Greenaway, Bridget Mooney and Bernie Wrobel. We undertake social visits to people living in residential care or in their own homes. We hope to help those who are no longer able to attend church keep in touch with the parish. Sometimes we are able to offer practical help such as a lift to church or an event. Although the SVP is a Catholic organization, the service is offered to people of all religions or none. It is an international organisation which was founded in the 19<sup>th</sup> century in Paris. In some areas groups are involved in running soup kitchens, visiting prisoners and organising holidays for deprived children. Our group is twinned with an SVP group in India and we make a small contribution to them and, when we can, help with specific projects. We have also recently donated £100 to the SVP Sudan appeal. We organise an entertainment and high tea for the housebound of the parish once a year. This includes groups from the local residential homes and is very popular. We meet every three weeks to join in prayer and to arrange our visits. We are, of course, all DBS checked.
