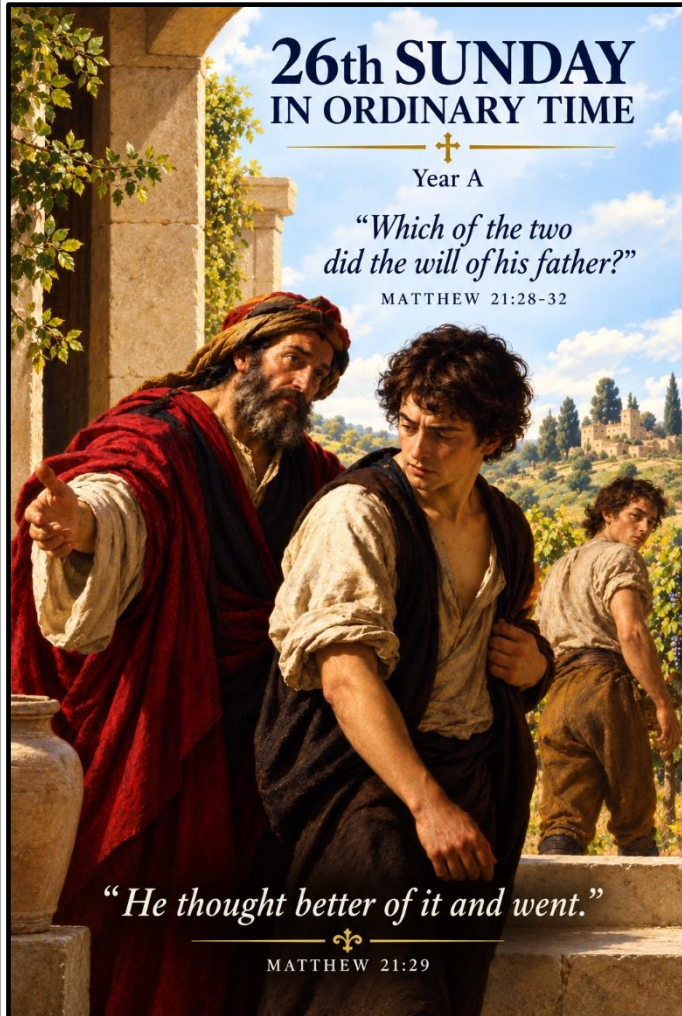

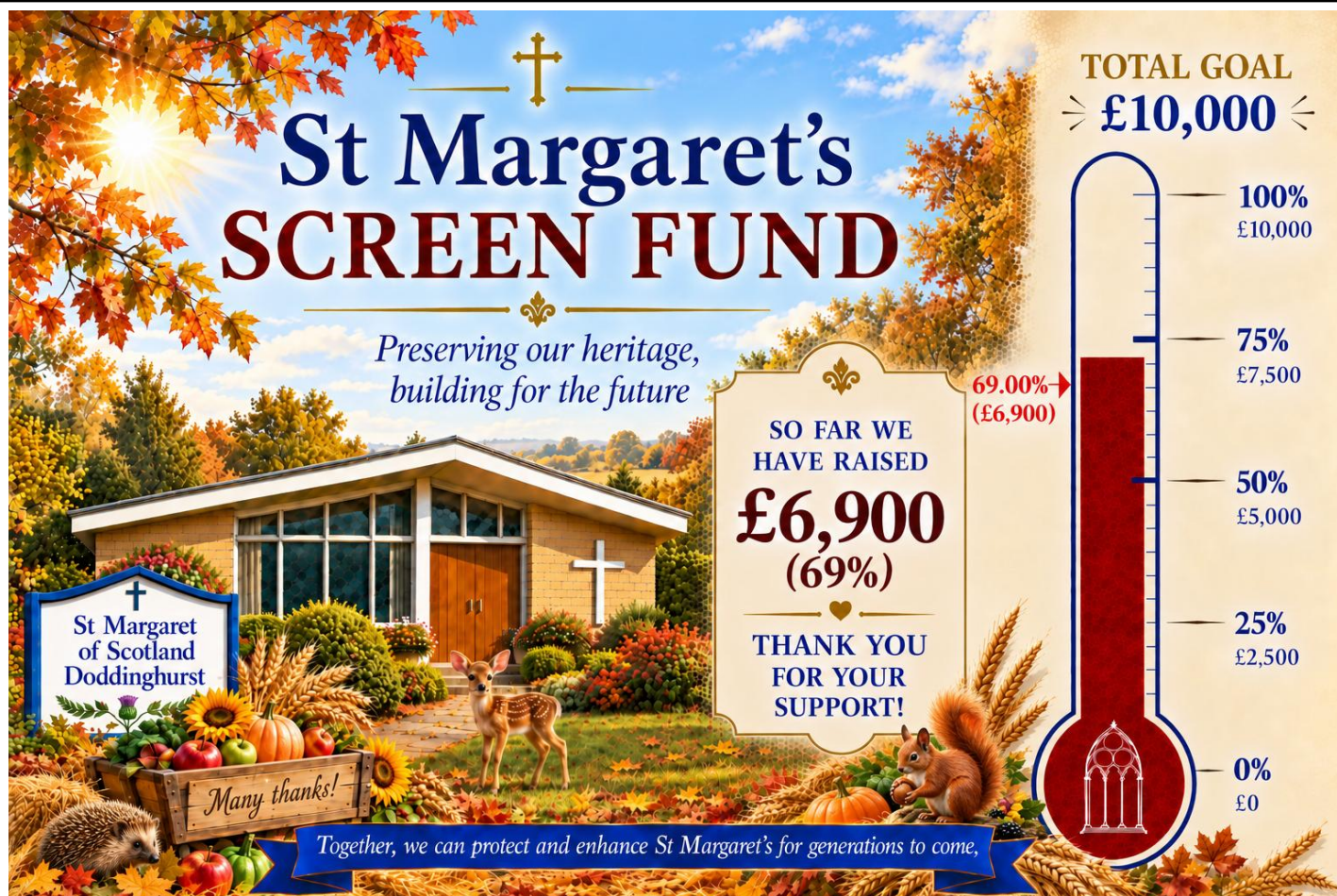

A heartfelt thank you to everyone who has contributed to St Margaret's Screen Fund. Every contribution, large or small, is greatly appreciated. Thank you

The floor-to-ceiling screen that divides the Church area from the main hall has become badly damaged and now needs to be replaced. This screen has served the parish faithfully for over **40 years**, enabling the building to function both as a place of worship and as a vital community hall.

While Church services take place on Sundays and Feast Days, the hall is used throughout the week as a lively community hub. It regularly hosts the **St Margaret's Pre-School, Doddinghurst Women's Institute, Musical Theatre Group**, monthly social **Doddy Drop-In**, village events, exercise classes, the **Christmas Party for the housebound**, and is available for private bookings. The screen is essential for allowing all these activities to continue safely and comfortably.

To install a new screen, we need to raise **£10,000**, and so we have launched a parish and local appeal.

Pope Leo has recently published *Magnifica Humanitas*, an encyclical letter on 'safeguarding the human person in the time of artificial intelligence'.

The Holy Father writes: 'In the era of artificial intelligence, when human dignity is threatened by new forms of dehumanisation, ours is the pressing duty to remain profoundly human.' Fr Hugh MacKenzie, chaplain at Westminster Cathedral, is an expert on AI. He will be giving a presentation on the topic on Saturday 26th September 2026 at the Catholic Church of Christ the Eternal High Priest in Gidea Park, beginning at 11 am. CAFOD Family Fast Day - Friday 2 October



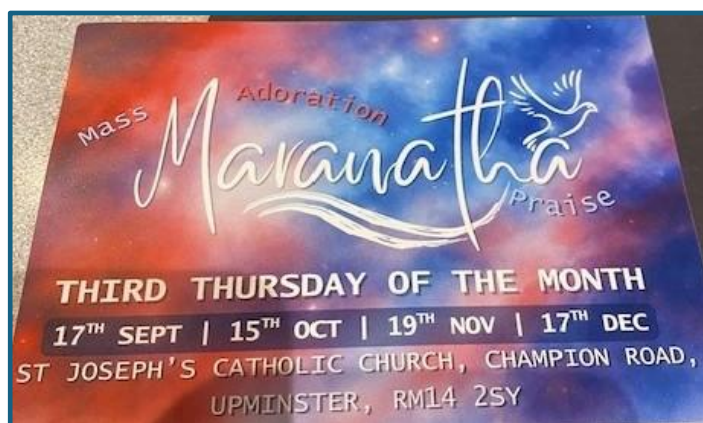

Doddington's first Michaelmas Fair will take place on Saturday 3rd October from 10am to 4pm, with free entry for all. The Fair celebrates our village's earliest mention in the Domesday Book of 1066, when officials recorded no households here—only woodland for 20 pigs, a single plough, and an annual tax of £1 paid by the French knight granted the land by William the Conqueror. The day will include a brass ensemble, circus skills, Morris dancing, the Schools choir, a mini museum, village memories, and a Michaelmas Daisy Festival in All Saints' Church. Most activities are free, though Cream Teas in the Priest's House and Ploughman's Lunches in the Village Hall require cash. The Scouts' medieval games use dried beans as currency, with 20 beans costing £5. The new Mayor of Brentwood, Cllr Nicky Cuthbert, will open the Fair at 10am, and King Henry VIII will be present throughout the day. We hope to see you there.
